2. PRESIDENT'S REPORT

In the Financial Year 2024 (FY24) Water Polo South Australia (WPSA) has continued our journey to develop an operational model that will deliver a continually improving experience for our clubs and playing members. Our strategy details the initiatives required to our goals and this journey will take several years.

For many years WPSA has struggled to deliver successful and sustainable growth for our sport. A key missing component has been the ability to provide professional staff levels and resources required to deliver our product to members.

During the FY24 WPSA appointed Eddie Denis to the position of General Manger and the process of refining our Strategy was expedited. This involved combining Eddie's vision for our sport in South Australia with the critical areas the WPSA Board identified in early 2023.

Some fundamental critical areas that have been improved are our accounting practices, operational performance, information to the Board, reestablishment of annual reports and awards nights, our contribution to Water Polo Australia (WPA) and communication with members.

Eddie's role is full time employment with WPA currently engaging Eddie for 2 of those days. There have been several roles for WPA since Eddie commenced. In my opinion the most significant was an assistant coach for the Australian Stingers in Paris this year. This sharing of roles is greatly beneficial to both organisations and shows WPA has faith in our direction.

As we are all aware 2024 presented significant challenges for WPSA with the redevelopment of the Adelaide Aquatic Centre (AAC). The new centre is scheduled to be completed around November 2025. An added difficulty to our operations is the closure of the diving pool at SAALC. We have worked closely with Government and other organisations on the best solutions with reduced pool space.

We have also been provided with significant influence over WPSA requirements within the new AAC centre. I believe this closure time will pass quickly but it will present challenges. During the closure period WPSA will further improve our operations in preparation for the new centre. The opening of the new centre will provide an immense opportunity for the development of our sport and all aquatic sports in South Australia.

For many years our participation in the Australian Water Polo League (AWL) has consumed enormous resources of WPSA. For most years, the Adelaide Jets have not been competitive for several reasons. In May 2024, WPSA established a WPSA AWL Review Committee. In June 2024 WPSA attended AWL Review Forum in Sydney. The WPSA Board considered all the relevant information and agreed with the WPSA AWL Review committee recommendation that the Adelaide Jets do not participate in the 2025 AWL Season. An additional recommendation was to invest our efforts into developing a Performance Academy as an athlete pathway. The Board implemented these changes in consultation with our club presidents. WPACT is an organisation that has flourished in membership levels and performance at national competitions without and AWL team.

A brief report on some improvements I believe have been implemented during FY24. Eddie Denis will provide greater detail in his report.

1. Improved relationships with WPA, SAALC, the South Australian Government and other sporting organisations
2. There has been improved communication and coordination of our local competitions.
3. Our equipment and plans are ready to implement Beach Polo this summer.
4. We have improved our equipment during 2024.
5. Several training initiatives have been implemented including refereeing, coaching and player training programs.
6. WPSA has agreed to join the National Redress Scheme on a part-participation basis.

2024 has been a very good year for obtaining new grants to fund events and growth projects. A significant grant was applied for and received for Beach Polo from the office of Recreation, Sport and Racing (ORSR). Another significant grant was received from WPA for Participation projects. Eddie will detail those success

stories. The one negative event was a grant reduction by ORSR on our annual grant due to Board composition. This has also highlighted some changes I believe are needed for our constitution.

Financially 2024 was a year we continued to invest in bringing WPSA up to an operating standard that is expected in this day and age and has been achieved by other sporting organisations. This resulted in additional expenditure that the Board believes has been necessary. Last financial year we returned to an improved standard of accounting practices but more improvement is needed. At the completion of FY24 time has been taken to evaluate income and expenses to ensure adjustments were applied to record the correct reporting period. The WPSA accounts have been recently issued to our auditor. WPSA is also in the process of establishing a formal budget for the current financial year.

In closing, I would like to thank and congratulate the WPSA Board, our staff members Eddie Denis and Anna Porcaro for their work and continued improvements to the WPSA organisation. At this AGM Matt Lawson has decided to complete his services to the WPSA Board due to work commitments. Matt has been an active Board participant, and his contribution has been greatly appreciated.

3. GENERAL MANAGER'S REPORT

General Manager's Report
WPSA Annual General Meeting 2024

Firstly, and importantly, I would like to acknowledge the immense contribution our volunteers, coaches and managers make to the functioning of our organisation. Every activity we undertake relies on the efforts of these key people and in particular our State teams, Adelaide Jets AWL teams, fundraising activities, WPSA events, AWL home games and State development programs would not be able to run without their on-going support. Thank you!

WPSA maintained stable membership this year comparable to the past three years. Our growth in numbers in younger age groups is steady, but our ability to retain members from year to year is an area we want to improve. We expect an uplift in membership in the 2024/25 summer season following the excitement of the Paris Olympic Games.

Our local 2023/24 summer season received overall positive feedback from members. The membership survey from 2023/24 highlighted key areas for enhancing the Summer Competition, in particular:

- Pre-planning: WPSA has held regular meetings with the clubs since June to plan for the 2024/25 season.
- Refereeing and Coaching: With the assistance of WPA, WPSA conducted coaching and refereeing courses in mid-October in preparation for the new summer season.

South Australia fielded 8 teams in the National State Competition and Australian Youth Competition this year, involving over 60 athletes. Notably, SA teams attended the 13U Development Carnival for the first time, with both teams achieving four wins and four losses.

Overall, our State Team results this year have been varied depending on the age group and level of competition. Alarmingly, we are seeing a general increase in the number of interstate draft players we include in our SA teams for each competition, and we are seeing an overall decline in the competitiveness of our State Teams.

In the AWL competition we have noted a similar trend. Even though the women's Adelaide Jets team achieved their best results in recent years, the AWL men's team again finished 11th and both teams relied on many interstate players to make them viable.

Based on these declining State team results the Board has agreed to revamp the WPSA State Development Programs, which have been in place for over 12 years. The changes will seek to fast track our next cohort of talented athletes to be ready to represent SA at the senior level in the AWL competition.

The revamped model will retain Development Squads for 13U and 15U athletes and introduce a new Performance Academy for the older age group athletes who are aspiring to progress in water polo and gain selection in the AWL Jets teams and Australian squads.

This year WPSA has secured two Grants to help facilitate the growth and visibility of our sport. WPSA successfully obtained a two-year grant from ORSR to run Beach Water Polo at three Lifesaving Clubs over the 2024/25 and 2025/26 summer seasons. WPSA also received substantial funding from WPA for the development of both a "Learn to Polo" swim school program at SAALC, and to upgrade our social water polo offerings within the summer season schedule.

Finally, I would like to thank the Board for their support for my role as Assistant Coach with the Aussie Stingers at the Paris Olympic Games. While South Australia did not have athlete representation on the Sharks or Stingers teams, as a State we supported the Olympic teams through Raf Sterk and myself as assistant coaches.

Again, I want to extend my gratitude to everyone who contributed their time and expertise to help deliver WPSA activities over the past year.

I look forward to your continued support in 2024/25.

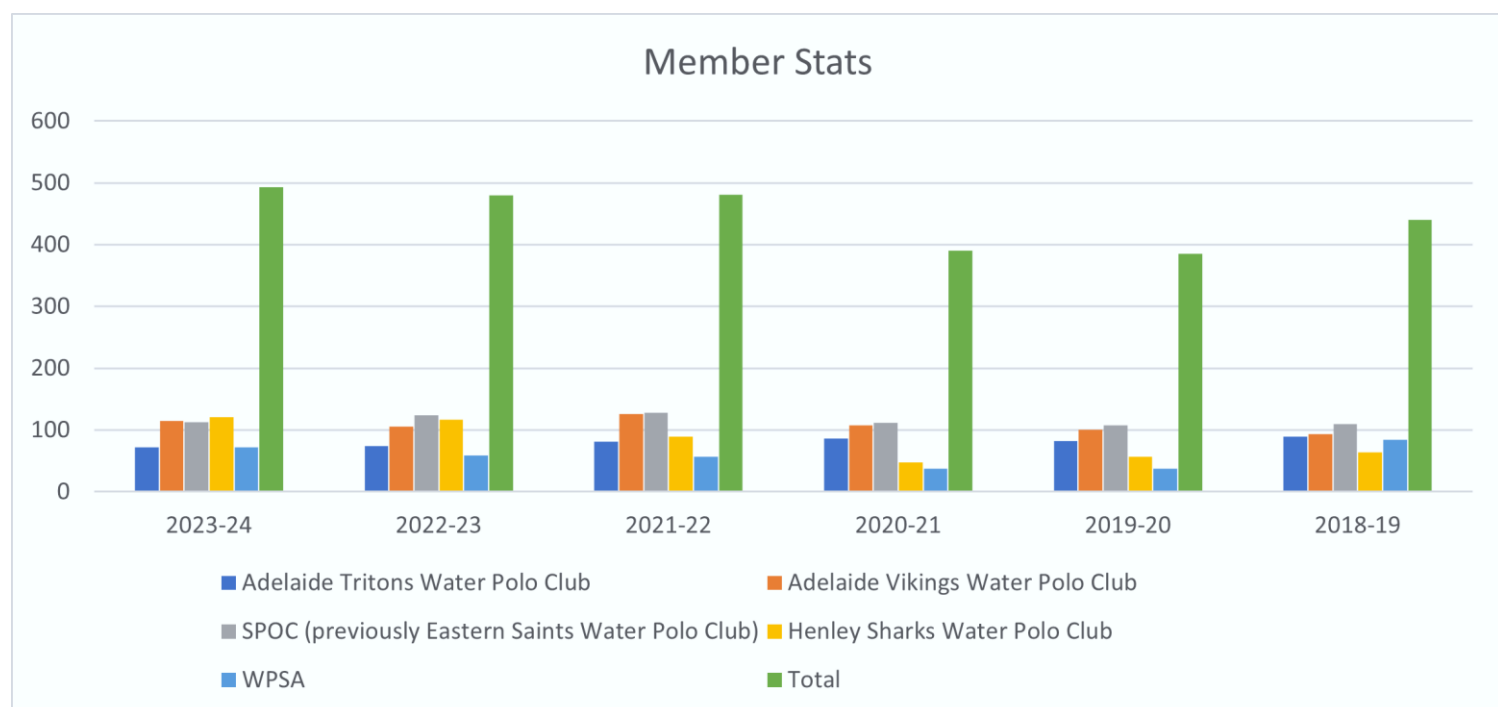

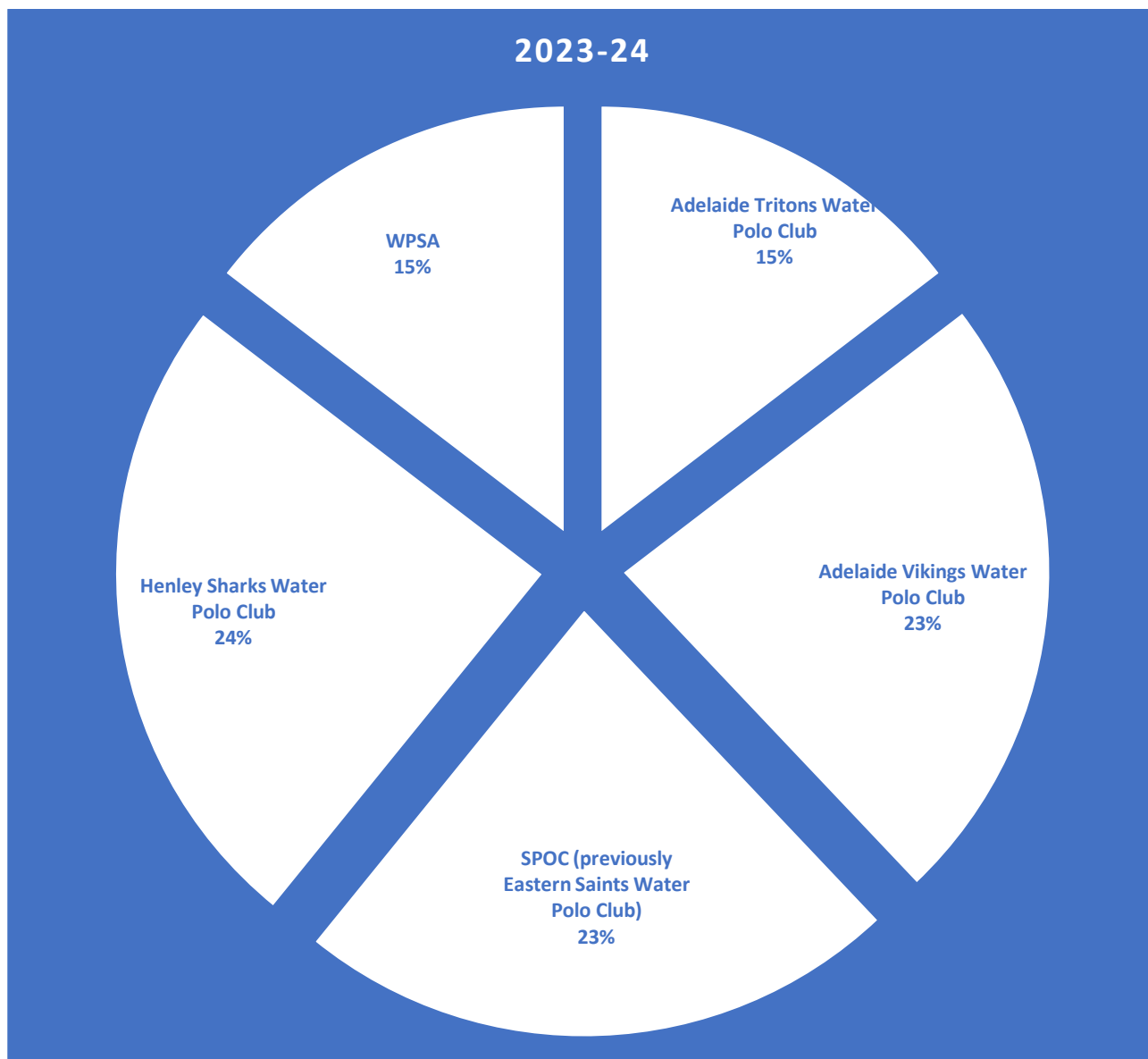
